2. The parade is open to any group or organization that is sponsored by Broken Bow Public Schools, or includes students from Broken Bow Schools. Also any organization or group that represents McCurtain County is welcome. Anyone interested in participating must return their entry form to Shari Magar at BBHS by October the 6th.
3. There will be three divisions for floats. Division 1 will include all school classes, Freshman, Sophomores, Juniors, and Seniors. Division2 will include any school organizations such as FFA, Stu-co, AILYC, Yearbook, Showtime, Band, Cheerleading, and Dance Team. Division 3 will include any organization that is not affiliated with the school such as Little Dixie, Little league teams, ect.
4. Floats ~~are~~ encouraged, we want to promote school spirit and would like to see lots of floats, or highly decorated vehicles.
5. Each parade entry will receive a entry number. These numbers must be posted on the vehicle in clear sight.
6. Entrants are expected to be at the BBHS parking lot NO LATER than 6:30 on Thursday October 12th. Line up will take place in the parking lot where you will find your entry number. Please enter the parking lot from the East coming from the middle school.
7. The parade route is as follows: The parade will begin at Broken Bow High School and Travel North on North Park Drive (hwy 259). The parade will follow North Park Drive to the Football Stadium. Floats are asked to park in the lot behind Bennett to disassemble.
8. All floats and vehicles need to stay TWO CAR lengths away from one another at all times. This is for safety and judging purposes.
9. Organization sponsors are in charge of the safety of their students at all times. No candy will be thrown from vehicles. Every Vehicle MUST have an adult in the cab at all times.
