Whereas, the Broken Bow Board of Education recognizes the chronic underfunding of public school education and continued cuts for more than a decade; and

Whereas, the Broken Bow Board of Education is a witness to the consequences of this chronic underfunding and sees the victims in our teachers, staff, students, families, community and state; and

Whereas, the Broken Bow Board of Education has supported and worked for solution after solution to fund teacher pay raises and common education, only to see the legislature fail to find common ground and pass legislation comprehensively addressing this emergency; and

Whereas, no one has worked harder nor waited longer for a raise and for resources in the classroom nor sacrificed more than our teachers; and

Whereas, on behalf of our students and families cannot allow this crisis to continue through another legislative session, we support all measures taken by our classroom teachers to demand the necessary funding for a meaningful teacher pay raise and education funding; and

Whereas, we are confident our community, including parents, families, caregivers, faith leaders and followers, business leaders, laborers, teachers' families and their school district administrators, neighbors and friends will gracefully fill the gap and make the sacrifices it will take while our teachers advocate for what they need to educate our children and secure the future of Oklahoma in ways they see fit.

Be it resolved that the Broken Bow Board of Education is in full support of our teachers and stands ready to take any steps necessary to improve conditions for our teachers – including a district wide suspension of classes on Monday, April 2nd and the sending of delegates to advocate for the cause.

The Broken Bow Board of Education urges the Oklahoma State Legislature to work urgently on behalf of the children and families in our state to take swift and meaningful action to develop a viable plan to pay teachers the professional salaries they deserve.
