



### ***Traditional learning***

**PK-12** students who choose **Traditional** learning will be expected to learn while physically on-campus in classrooms. All classrooms will be staffed with a certified teacher and learning will be in the classroom but will be paired with a digital component. For grades PK-12, students will use Google Classroom and be trained how to utilize it in the event of a closure/distance learning opportunity. In the event an individual, class, or school has to be quarantined or isolated due to COVID-19, the digital component (Google Classroom ) will become the distance learning platform. Packets may be made accessible for those who lack connectivity or device until a process for providing access can be instituted.

### ***Virtual learning (Full-time & Part-time)***

**K-12** students who choose **Virtual** learning will be expected to learn while off-campus in a virtual learning environment.

- **Grades K-2** will be served instruction through Google Classroom
- **Grades 3-5** through Google Classroom and Exact Path
- **Grades 6 -12** will be served instruction by way of the Edmentum Courseware program.

Students will be managed by certified teachers and monitored by a school counselor and the Principal of Instruction. **Part-time Virtual** students in grades 6-12 will still be eligible to participate in school sponsored extracurricular activities (athletics, fine arts, vo-ag, etc.) as long as the student is enrolled in that elective and physically attends the class on campus during that class period. Students taking this option will be required to meet all state guidelines, including taking state assessments appropriate to grade level. ***Transportation will not be provided by the district for students choosing Virtual learning.***

Students who wish to enroll in **Virtual** learning must complete an application and be approved through the building principal. Enrollment deadline is due by August 10th.

### ***Registration Process/Additional Information for Virtual Learning***

An application for **Virtual** learning can be found on our website at [www.bbisd.org](http://www.bbisd.org). In order to choose this option, the Powerschool online enrollment process **MUST** be completed first and then the student may complete an application for **Virtual**. The family may be contacted to gather additional information if necessary.

It is strongly recommended that a student choosing the **Virtual** learning option, remains in the program for a minimum of one semester.

For elementary students (K-6) who choose **Virtual**, parents must agree there will be adult supervision available at home to help students manage virtual learning.

In order to be successful in **Virtual**, students will be required to communicate with their assigned virtual teacher on a regular basis, as well as maintain online progress. **Students will be expected to log into the virtual learning platform and complete assignments by the end of each school week.** *[School days are defined as any day a student is expected to be in attendance (Monday-Friday) according to the school calendar.*
